Our program at Sacred Heart is *Be My Disciples*. This is on the US Bishops approved list. The program uses reflection on Scripture and doctrine and prayer celebrations in every lesson and during all the major seasons of the Church year.

Families will be able to access a number of on-line resources to develop the best catechetical experience for their families. Activities, resources, and articles will help families discover ideas on how to live as disciples of Christ. These include prayers, Gospel and lectionary resources, the USCCB Web Site, the Vatican Web Site, student sites with chapter reviews, games, and more.

We also offer two faith opportunities for adults and older teens.

- *Voices of the Church: A Journey with the Fathers and Doctors*—a weekly presentation from the Cathedral of St John Berchmans. The talks are posted each Sunday on Sacred Heart's website. A compilation of original source materials used in the presentations is available on the parish website in a pdf format.
- *1st Wednesdays Family Faith Formation*—we are beginning the second year of this parish program. On October 7th at 7pm, Fr James will lead a discussion on prayer. Parishioners are invited to attend either in person or on Facebook (live stream). Fr James will include the following (1) Eucharistic Adoration, (2) The importance of prayer (especially daily prayer), (3) Different kinds of prayer, (4) Unanswered Prayers and Questions & Answers from audience.
